The Criminal Justice Program combines the study of criminal law, and law enforcement, in a practical yet creative manner. This course of study will prepare students for a variety of careers in or related to the justice system. Students who choose this degree path will find that there are a variety of career choices.

Careers in public safety include front-line positions such as local law enforcement officers, and correctional officers. Law & Criminal Justice explores the history, legal structures and institutions of law and legality in the Bahamian/British system.

The program explores the process of law making, the structure of the judiciary, the sources and forms of law and substantive civil and criminal laws, rights and remedies.
